CENSUS, SURVEY, ESTIMATE, PROJECTION

Decennial Census data – the goal is to get responses from100% of the population; data of less than 100% is "imputed". Product: *Decennial Census*

Survey data – the goal is to get responses from a percentage of the population; data of less than this percentage is "imputed". Products: *American Community Survey*, one-year data and multiyear data

Estimates and Projections data – this data comes from using various data sources, including birth and death data. The basic difference between Estimates and Projections is this simple: Estimates data focuses on the present and past, Projections data focuses on the future.

Products: Annual Population Estimates, National Population Projections, State Projections
